ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Sri Balaji Educational Society, Plot No. 18-1-335, Venugopal Nagar Road, Anantapur Village & Post, Anantapur Taluk and City, Anantapur District -515001, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an on-line application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 08.06.2015 and submitted printouts on 10.06.2015 for grant of recognition for D.El.Ed-A.I Programme of one unit of 50 Students at Balaji Elementary Teacher Education, Khasra No. 2076, 2077-4, 2078, 2077-6 Plot No. 9, Khaja Nagar, Near RTC, Anantapur Village & Post, Anantapur Taluk and City, Anantapur District - 515001, Andhra Pradesh

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and Videography and the certificates received from the university, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE ACT, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc. for running the programme.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE ACT, 1993 the Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Balaji Elementary Teacher Education, Khasra No. 2076, 2077-4, 2078, 2077-6 Plot No. 9, Khaja Nagar, Near RTC, Anantapur Village & Post, Anantapur Taluk and City, Anantapur District - 515001, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed-A.I programme of two years duration with an additional intake of 50 students from the academic session 2016-2017 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions -

- I The Endowment fund of 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained Perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
 - II The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - IV The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in Position.
- 2 Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
 - 3 The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.
 - 4 The institutions shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake, availability of physical infrastructure such as Ind. building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities, instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely -
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.

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- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter
 - d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e) Fee charged from students.
 - f) Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application
 - j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires
 - k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 4 The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website
- 5 The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section17(1) of the NCTE Act.

PREAMBLE :

Read: Notification of NCTE, New Delhi dated.01.01.2004 published in the Gazette of India Part III – Section 4 as No.3 on 05.01.2004

The NCTE, New Delhi in its Notification dated.01.01.2004 decided to dispense with the requirement of "No Objection Certificate" from State/UT Government for those institutions already running B.Ed programmes recognised by NCTE and seeking recognition to start a course or training in Elementary Teacher Education for a period of three years from the date of notification of these regulations in the Official Gazette.

The Balaji Educational Society, Anantapur – 515001, Andhra Pradesh is running Balaji College of Education, Khajanagar, Near RTC Bus Stand, Anantapur District – 515001, Andhra Pradesh which has been granted recognition by SRC-NCTE has submitted an application to start Elementary (D.Ed) course by deriving the benefit of above said regulation on 30.01.2004.

The application for starting Balaji Elementary Teacher Education, Khajanagar, Near RTC Bus Stand, Anantapur – 515001, Andhra Pradesh was considered by SRC-NCTE under Section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, inspection of the institution was carried out on 30.04.2005 and the report of inspection team and other documents furnished by the institution along with the application were considered by the Southern Regional Committee in its meeting held on 19-20 July, 2005. The Regional Committee observed that the institution has made satisfactory arrangements in respect of infrastructural and instructional facilities for starting D.Ed course and decided to permit the institution to start Elementary (D.Ed) course from the session 2005-06.

Hence the order.

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In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the **Balaji Educational Society, Anantapur – 515001, Andhra Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE seeking permission to start **Balaji Elementary Teacher Education, Khajanagar, Near RTC Bus Stand, Anantapur – 515001, Andhra Pradesh** for **Elementary(D.Ed) Course of two years** duration from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **50** students.

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2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
- The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
 - The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 lakhs.
 - The institution has identified the **Principal and five** teachers for the said course.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to start **Balaji Elementary Teacher Education, Khajanagar, Near RTC Bus Stand, Anantapur – 515001, Andhra Pradesh** for **Elementary (D.Ed)** course of **two years** duration from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
- The institution will ensure that **Principal and Five** faculty members duly approved by the Director, SCERT, Hyderabad are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of admissions and a copy of approved staff list shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the admissions.
 - The institution shall, within three months of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - The institution shall shift both B.Ed & D.Ed courses to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition of B.Ed college as the recognition for D.Ed is issued based on existence of B.Ed college and Notification dated.01.01.2004 of NCTE. (in case the B.Ed / D.Ed course is started in rented premises).
 - The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

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
